We pray that JESUS will be for you - a Reason, a Season and a Lifetime!!





It was founded by a Canadian, Jean Vanier.) Roman came to The Welcome Home to engage in volunteer experience and to serve where there is need.

Olesia Panas — Olesia is 23 years old. She comes from L'viv, Ukraine. Her sister, Nadia, was at The Welcome Home for the last two years. Olesia studied design and surveying at university. She volunteered with the Redemptorists in orphanages in Ukraine and attended our parish of St. Josaphat in L'viv. She came to The Welcome Home because she heard a lot about it from her sister. She wants to work with children and adults at The Welcome Home and in other organizations who help the poor here in Winnipeg.
